## Science

We will be learning about light and dark. We'll look at different light sources and at how light casts a shadow, both with electrical light sources and, weather permitting, how the sun casts a shadow.

## Humanities

We have an historical focus this half term and will be learning all about 1666 and the Great Fire of London. By the end of the topic we'll have experienced another event that has informed our modern day life.

## Technology/Art

In our Art lessons we will be making silhouettes of people, objects and buildings  
Food tech is all about bread and dough—pizza is sure to feature and hopefully we'll get to watch the magic of yeast.

## PSHCE

Our focus in PSHCE is stranger danger including staying safe. We'll be working hard to understand who it is safe to ask for help should we need it. We will also be thinking about staying safe when we are out and about.

## Home learning

Explore different light sources (safely!) - switching ceiling lights and lamps on and off, candles and torches. Try changing the colour of the light from a torch or lamp by holding different fabrics in front of them.

Practice fine motor skills manipulating your hands to make different finger puppet silhouettes

Bake some bread—make sure you knead the dough enough—look at how the dough grows. Build on your numeracy skills and make given number of rolls
