This half term's topic is:

'On The Farm'

Key Words

Farm, town, countryside,
plants, fruit, vegetables, grow,
animal names.

Visits Out

We will be visiting different towns and countryside areas and garden centres to look at the different types of plants they sell. Yellow Class will enjoy a weekly visit to Forest School

Science

We will be learning about how plants grow. This will involve identifying parts of the plant and sorting according to different criteria. We will begin to understand which parts of different plants are safe to eat.

Humanities

We will be focussing on the similarities and differences between town and countryside. There will be some role-play opportunities for the pupils during our topic lessons.

Technology/Art

Food Technology: We will be preparing fruit and vegetables ready to use them in a variety of recipes.

Art: We will be using fruit and vegetable to paint and designing and making a scarecrow.

PSHE

Our focus in PSHE is 'We Are All Stars', where the pupils will be sharing things they are good at and enjoy doing in and out of school as well as thinking about what being a good friend means.
