Key Words

Food, world, rainforest, to look, seasons, rocks, soil, treasure, explore, find, hide, health, play, name, diversity

Visits Out

We will be visiting our usual range of locations linked to our learning, hopefully we'll get as far as Wyre Forest for a long 'explorer' style walk. Red Class will enjoy a weekly visit to Forest School

Science

We will be learning about rocks and soils. There'll be lots of exploring textures and using our skills to describe what we see and feel. We're also going to make a volcano—WOW!!

Humanities
