Understanding the World

Expressive Arts

Art: We will be exploring new techniques including pendulum painting, splat painting and bubble painting as we create pictures of transport.

Music: we will sing old favourites and new songs on the theme of 'Up, 'Up and Away'.

We will be learning about fairtrade foods and exploring how chocolate is made

In Food Technology we will be making soups and salads. We will practise our grating and chopping skills.
