## 'Walking with Dinosaurs'

### Key Words

### Physical Development

Gross Motor skills: Pupils will continue to enjoy weekly PE sessions on Fridays. Soft Play sessions will be on Tuesday afternoons and this term, Orange and Green class will take turns to go.

Fine Motor Skills: these will be practised across the curriculum, with creative opportunities in Art and Topic lessons.

### Expressive Arts

Our main focus this half term will be on Art where we will be making salt dough fossils and looking at animal skeletons. We will explore different ways to make dinosaur prints.
