How well are we achieving our aims?

Any incidents of challenging behaviour are regularly analysed in order for school, parents, carers and outside agencies to work together to achieve a consistent approach.

Staff support children individually within and outside of the classroom setting to ensure their needs are met.

Praise and encouragement is the approach used throughout the school and positive rewards are given for individual efforts and achievements.

Training and support is given to all staff to ensure that all staff are competent and confident in following policy and procedures. This is delivered by the in house team of trainers, led by the headteacher. "We aim to provide early intervention support with families, in order to solve problems and strengthen relationships and ensure our pupils are happy and ready to learn"
