'Understanding my Emotions'

Key Words

Community Engagement

Due to the current restrictions pupils will only be accessing outdoor provision, we'll be visiting parks and going on lots of walks. Red Class will enjoy a weekly visit to Forest School.

Science

We'll be learning about 'humans'. Linking bones to muscles, comparing human bones to animal bones and investigating the link between our breathing and heartbeat - hopefully we can try some exercise to see how these change.

Humanities

Technology/ Art

Food Technology: our starting point this year is food hygiene and PPE. Expect your child to tell you to wash your hands and wear an apron when you're cooking the dinner!!

Computing : what is a computer? We'll be finding out what everything does including keeping safe when using the Internet

Art: Our focus is drawing, we'll be using a range of media on a range of surfaces, hopefully it won't get too messy!!

Spend some time doing a bit of cooking at home – can your child remember what they've learned in school about food hygiene?? Any samples gratefully accepted !!

Join in with using different things to draw with, why not get all sensory and use some different food stuffs—berries are good!
