Forest School

Our Theme for this term is A Walk in the Woods.

Expressive arts and design

This term we will be exploring different Nursery Rhymes in Music, printing with a wide range of tools in Art and exploring a range of foods with our senses in Food Technology.

Maths

In Maths this half term we will be focusing on counting, sequencing and ordering numbers using counting songs and a range of activities. We will be exploring different sized and shaped objects. We will be exploring spatial awareness in the classroom and elsewhere around school.

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Understanding The World

In Understanding of the World, we will be exploring the changes in weather that happens during Autumn, how we can dress to keep warm.

We will be looking at and learning about simple body parts, identifying them on our bodies and pointing to them. We will also be exploring our own reflection in mirrors as well as our peers.

We will be looking at pictures of ourselves, friends and our family members and identifying who they are. We will be looking at similarities and differences in our appearances.

Physical Development

This term we will be practising throwing and releasing objects, moving on a range of surfaces and developing our climbing skills on a range of play equipment.

We will also be practising action songs in class daily throughout the day.

PSED

In PSED we will be exploring "Who is special to me?" We will be looking at the different roles of family members and friends.

Engagement

Visits into the community continue across the term. We will be using our topic of "All about me" to explore the local environment and identify things we enjoy, where we live, what pets we own at home and places we like to visit with our families.
