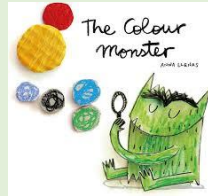
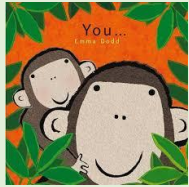


English

Our Little Wandle phonics lessons will continue 4 days a week enabling your to child to continue to develop their listening skills through games, songs, rhymes, and sensory massage. This half term our focus texts are 'You' by Emma Dodd and 'The Colour Monster' by Anna Llanas. We will explore these texts through a range of sensory based activities. Maths

In Maths this half term we will continue explore pre- number skills through sensory interactive activities. You can reinforce these skills with your child through activities such as listening to number songs, finding numbers in your environment and counting as you do things in the home and when out and about.

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Science

In Science, we are going to be focussing on 'Seasonal Changes'. A sensory approach will be used through the term, as we explore the different colours, animals and temperate changes we find and experience throughout the seasons.



Physio

All pupils with a Physio programme will continue to follow these each week. Rebound sessions will take place throughout the week and will provide a combination of building strength, co-ordination, and relaxation. Some pupils will take part in Hydrotherapy sessions on Wednesday mornings.

Computing

In Computing, we are going to be focussing on 'Big Mac Play'. We will explore how we use Big Mac's and aim to use them with less adult support throughout the term to develop communication.



Music

Del from Dudley Performing Arts will continue to visit each Friday – we look forward to learning new songs and practising familiar songs. We will explore lots of different instruments and a range of musical genres.

Horticulture

This term we will be exploring nature through Forest School lessons and will have the opportunity to visit Forest School at our Pensnett site.

In Horticulture we will be exploring the topic 'Squashes for Autumn.'



Food Technology

In Food Technology, we will be learning about Harvest.

Rainbow class are going to learn all about why we celebrate the Harvest Festival and what foods are involved in this.

We will also be organising our very own Harvest Festival here in school.

We will be taking donations for the food bank and visiting the food bank to deliver our donation.



Art and Design

This term, we will be focusing on our Printing skills. We will be focusing on artwork by Henri Matisse, particularly 'The Snail' and 'The Sheaf'. We will be using a range of tools to print with such as, our hands, vegetables, and everyday objects.



RE and PSHE
