

<p>English</p> <p>This term continues with the story 'The Nature Girls' by Aki Delphine Mach. We be expanding on our sensory based activities to broaden our sensory experiences in relation to the story with the support of story massage. We will look at themed rhymes and recreate experiences of what it feels like to experience an aeroplane flight and a snowy and icy adventure!</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>This terms topic is Number with a focus on 1 and lots. We will be using nursery rhymes to support our learning including Twinkle Twinkle and Once I caught a Fish Alive. Sensory experiences will support our learning as we begin to compare 1 and lots through printing and other sensory exploration activities.</p>	<p>Physio</p> <p>Pupils continue to follow their physio programmes, throughout the week, to develop their physical health and wellbeing based on the advice provided by both internal and external professionals as identified on their individual plans.</p> <p>PE</p> <p>This terms topic in PE is 'cricket'. We will be looking into the sounds related to cricket, the feel of the equipment needed and having a go at developing our gross motor skills to hold a bat and hit a ball.</p>
<p>Work Related Learning</p> <p>Pupils will have the opportunity to engage in a range of onsite and offsite work-related learning opportunities including the farm, Baggeridge and Hawbush community Gardens. Students accessing onsite activities will include site maintenance, catering and hospitality, administration and library work at our Ridge Hill site. Enterprise will also be experienced.</p> <p>Preparation for Adulthood</p> <p>For these sessions pupils will be in different groups when they will be joining in with Art, Rebound and games, Dance, or Enterprise. We will link sensory food experiences to songs and stories to broaden our experiences of a range of celebrations and festivals.</p>	<p>Art and Design</p> <p>Music through Story will be our focus this half term as we engage in a wide range of musical activities exploring instruments, emotions linked to songs and how we indicate our preferences. We will encounter a selection of familiar and unfamiliar rhymes and of course engage in Christmas songs in the lead up to our Christmas Concert at Dudley town hall.</p>
