


<p>English</p> <p>Our Little Wandle phonics lessons will continue 4 days a week this half term and your child will continue to develop their understanding of sounds and letters.</p> <p>This half term we are reading Colours, Colours Everywhere by Julia Donaldson and Father Christmas Comes Out Trumps by Nicholas Allan.</p> <p>Please see our reading newsletter for information about our Author of the Month.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>In maths this half term we are focusing on the fundamental skills of Number. We will be engaging with a range of number activities to develop our current knowledge.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>In Science, we are going to be focussing on 'My Body'.</p> <p>We are going to be naming, identifying and label basic body parts such as face, eyes, nose, mouth, ears, hair and teeth.</p> <p>We will understand that the body is made up of different parts which all have their own names, we will access this through a range of practical activities.</p>	
<p>PE</p> <p>In PE we will be focussing on Dance.</p> <p>We are going to be learning dance routines linked to familiar dance songs such as the Cha Cha Slide. <p>History</p> <p>In History, our topic is 'Keeping in Touch'. We are going to be learning how keeping in contact with people has changed over time from sending letters to sending emails.</p> <p>We will also look at matching types of communication to times in the past.</p>	<p>Engagement</p> <p>This half term we will be visiting the community with a link to our History topic, we will be posting letters that we have written to people we know.</p> <p>We will also have a visit to a local Library.</p>		
<p>Computing</p> <p>In Computing, we are focussing on 'Digital Drawing'. Pupils are going to be working on opening a word processor, recognising keys on a keyboard, identifying and recognising keys on a keyboard. We will then move onto adding and removing text onto a computer.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>We are focussing on 'Introducing Sway'. We are going to be learning actions linked to familiar songs such as I'm A Little Teapot and The Grand Old Duke Of York. We will be using a range of sensory materials such as ribbons and materials to learn the swaying movement.</p>	<p>Art and Design</p> <p>We are focussing on our drawing skills through the topic of 'Houses'.</p> <p>We are going to be learning that shapes and lines can produce artwork We are going to be learning what a sketch is and learn that Art can be created by people all over the world, including us!</p>	<p>Forest School</p> <p>This half term we will be accessing Forest School. The topic we are focussing on is 'Glorious Mud'.</p> <p>Our Forest School sessions will take place at P14, therefore please ensure your child has suitable clothing and footwear to access these sessions e.g. all in ones and wellies. Please ensure names are in your child's clothing.</p>
		<p>RE and PSHE</p> <p>In PSHE, we will be learning about different emotions and how we express them. We will be developing our emotional literacy.</p> <p>In RE, we will be learning about Celebrations in different cultures. We will focus on this during an RE focus day.</p>
