<p><b>Soft Play</b></p> <p>In our community visit to soft play on the school minibus our focus will be on gross motor skills. Pupils will be encouraged to interact with each other, take turns and share with sensory experiences.</p>	<p><b>Engagement</b></p> <p>This half term we will be visiting the community with a link to our Geography topic 'Where I Live'.</p> <p>We will also have a visit to a local Library.</p>		
<p><b>Computing</b></p> <p>In Computing, we are going to be focussing on Technology in Our Environment'. We will learn that technology is something that helps us, identify different examples of technology, learn that some technology can be used in more than one way and that there are rules to keep us safe when we use technology.</p>	<p><b>Music</b></p> <p>We are focussing on three skills: listening, musicianship and singing. We will be listening to music from different genres, making sounds with a range of instruments and singing a range of our favourite songs.</p>	<p><b>Art and Design</b></p> <p>We are focussing on self-portraits. We will apply our learning from our Science topic to identify our facial features. We will learn what a self-portrait is and that different facial features need to be represented. We will learn that features of a face are drawn inside an outline and that art can be created by different people all over the world.</p>	<p><b>Swimming</b></p> <p>On a Wednesday morning, we will be going for swimming. We have a private session where the children will learn fundamental skills and safety around water and swimming. Other vital skills are involved in this such as getting dressed, transition, and being in the local community.</p>
		<p><b>RE and PSHE</b></p> <p>In PSHE, we will be focussing on 'What Makes a Family'.</p> <p>In RE, we will be asking the question 'Why am I special?' . We will focus on this during an RE focus day.</p>
